GENERAL FENCE REGULATIONS:

To review the full City Ordinance regarding fences, visit www.cityofhomedale.org. Chapter 15.24

1. Electric and barbed wire fences are prohibited.
2. The use of dangerous material such as boxes, sheet metal or broken masonry blocks are prohibited.
3. In the event that any fence restricts access to established rights-of-way or easements, it is the fence owner's responsibility, at their expense, to provide access upon demand.
4. Any fence located within the clear vision is limited to 36". The clear vision triangle is defined by measuring from the intersection of the edges of two adjacent roadways forty feet (40') along each roadway and connecting the two points with a straight line.
5. If the water meter for the property will be inside the proposed fence, you are required to provide an access gate.
6. Solid fences or closed non-vision fences are allowed up to 36", or open-vision type fences up to 48", may be built from the front of the dwelling up to five feet (5') from the curb or to the inside of the existing sidewalk.
7. Fences to a height of 72" may be built from the front of the dwelling to the rear property line.
